

## Studebaker Museum attracts 11,300 visitors in 100 days by MARGARET FOSMOE

SOUTH BEND – Classic sandwiches and salads are being served up right next to Champions, Larks and other classic vehicles.

A cafe recently opened in the lobby of Studebaker National Museum, 201 S. Chapin St. It's called the 1st Source Cafe, after its corporate sponsor. The food preparation and service are provided by The Culinary Connection in Mishawaka. The breakfast menu includes bagels, muffins, cereal and fruit bars, as well as coffee, tea and juices. The lunch menu offers two types of sandwiches and two salads. Salads and sandwiches are priced \$3 to \$4. Museum admission is not required to visit the cafe. Museum staff hope the new cafe becomes a regular draw for people grabbing coffee on their way to work and a lunch spot for downtown workers, said Patti Doyle, the museum's special projects coordinator. The cafe has seats for 20 customers. A nearby patio will provide additional seating during warm weather. The partners of The Culinary Connection sought the museum space in order to expand their customer base to South Bend. The Culinary Connection opened in December at 713 N. Main St., Mishawaka. The Mishawaka location offers "grab-and-go" bistro-style dinners, desserts and specialty coffees. The business is operated by partners Joseph Catanzariti, Brett Boomhower and Audra Nixon.


