
DIRECTIONS TO Bethlehem

BMW & Champion Designer Albrecht Graf Goertz Dies



In 1940, Goertz was called up into the US Army and did five years of service on the Pacific front. Following his return to civilian life in 1945, he met Raymond Loewy, then the preeminent figure in industrial design. He helped Goertz to gain a place of study at the Pratt Institute in Brooklyn

Worked with Raymond Loewy to design the Studebaker Champion—the so-called “bullet nose”

and subsequently took him on as a junior designer in his Studebaker

development department. Here Goertz and a colleague designed the successful facelift of the Studebaker Champion - the so-called "bullet nose".




President's Message:
