

A statement from The Studebaker Drivers Club, Inc. March 16, 2020



Manufacturer: Studebaker Motor Corp. South Bend, Indiana Type: 4-Door Sedan

The original owners of this vehicle were Richard and Ruth Bricker of Hershey, PA. Ruth became interested in a '63 Lar on the current owner's father's used car lot. (She said she only drove Studebakers her whole life except for one Erskine.) She bought the '63, but her '59 Lark wasn't traded because its condition was worthy of salvage. It was on the lot one day after school, wouldn't run, had burnt valves, the front fenders were badly rusted, and the interior was sad. Mr. Miller was 15 and started tinkering with the Lark. Ruth spotted him tinkering, told his father she wanted to give it to him, and he became its proud owner.

They pulled the engine, sent it out for overhaul, somehow patched it to pass inspection, and he began driving it to Palmyra High School. A year later they started the slow restoration process. It took all but 21 years to finish. Once, when asked why a door didn't fit right, Ruth responded that she once swerved to miss an animal on the exit ramp at 322 and Hershey Park Drive and rolled the car on its roof. She was hanging upside down by the seat belt when some folks stopped to rescue her. They just rolled the car over and she drove it home. The Body work and paint was done by Jeff Blose. The interior was bought from Phantom Auto Works and installed by Gerald Harclerode. The Lark is a joy to drive





SOME THOUGHTS ON RESTORING A STUDEBAKER

Written by Chuck Lampman, this 99-page book is based on articles written by Chuck Lampman, North Georgia Chapter SDC member, that appeared in *Turning Wheels* in the early 1990's and won the SDC Churchill Award for Best Article, Non-paid. Some material edited out of *Turning Wheels* is included

in the book as well as updates and several new items written after the Turning Wheels series was published. "Some Thoughts" is aimed at the first-time restorer but will be of value to the more experienced. It is not intended to be a "how to restore" book but gives a look at the decision-making processes, tools, spaces, and basic skills needed to do a restoration.
