Hello Studebaker Lovers







What's In Our Garage?

Wayne Lee came up with the idea of having members answer the question, "What's in your garage?" This would be a fun and interesting way to learn more about each other and our old car hobby.

Wayne also volunteered information about his own garage, as follows:

The Lee family garage is home to our 1941 Champion. It's an older street rod with a GM V6/automatic that we're slowly fixing to get back on the street. The green 2-tone paint emulates the original 1941 paint job. The 1948 yellow pickup wears later sheet metal and is powered by a GM V8 & automatic. Just finished building the new front bumper from some old GT Hawk pieces donated by Stephen Allen. Manifold & carburetor changes are planned next.

The battleship gray 1957 Transtar belongs to our Son Eric. It sits on a mid-90s GM chassis with a fuel injected V8/automatic & A/C. That slick front bumper is off the back of a Zip Van! After we finish the bodywork it'll be white over blue.

The 1951 Willys Wagon is the newest member of the family and needs only minimal updates.


• President Terry Ziemer adjourned the meeting at 2:45 PM.

SOME THOUGHTS ON RESTORING A STUDEBAKER

Written by Chuck Lampman, this 99-page book is based on articles written by Chuck Lampman, North Georgia Chapter SDC member, that appeared in *Turning Wheels* in the early 1990's and won the SDC Churchill Award for Best Article, Non-paid. Some material edited out of *Turning Wheels* is included

in the book as well as updates and several new items written after the Turning Wheels series was published. "Some Thoughts" is aimed at the first-time restorer but will be of value to the more experienced. It is not intended to be a "how to restore" book but gives a look at the decision-making processes, tools, spaces, and basic skills needed to do a restoration. It also provides a framework to help structure a project and contains several chapters of Studebaker-specific advice.
