Call to Order and Opening Discussion: The meeting was called to order by President Bill Startt at 2:40 PM. Minutes from the prior meeting were approved by consent.

Introduction of Guests: We had a good turnout; twenty-two chapter members were in attendance. No guests or new members were present.

Members with Health Issues or Condolences: Buddy Hunt has been struggling with general health issues. To make things even worse, he had a fire in his house as reported by Charleen Carey. Buddy is okay, and his health continues to improve slowly.

Birthdays and Anniversaries: People in attendance celebrating birthdays or anniversaries in May or June included Bill and Kathy Startt (54-year anniversary on June 28^{th)}, Alan and Rochelle Ziglin (53rd anniversary the following week), Tim Taylor (birthday on May 24), and Terry Smith (birthday on June 4).

Vice-President's Comments: Joe attended the recent national Studebaker swap meet on June 2nd in South Bend and said it was poorly attended. Check our Facebook page to see photos.

Treasurer's Report: Wayne Ziemer provided a treasurer's report. Our account balance is currently \$4,166.81, up by \$10 since the last report. A motion was made and passed to continue with our sponsored Studebaker Commander at the Studebaker Museum (\$250). (Just noted that David Stone's last name is misspelled on "Adopted by" sign).

Membership Chairperson's Report: Terry Ziemer provided a Cornerstone Report as found in the *Turning Wheels* latest issue. Currently, two members of our local chapter are not up-to-date with paying their annual dues to the National club. Four were previously reminded; no names were provided. Terry reported that there is a new SDC member in Lafayette, GA, and she will reach out to see whether that new member is interested in joining our chapter.

Alan Z. reported that there is a membership option to the National that costs only \$12 annually if one chooses not to receive the Turning Wheels newsletter.

Newsletter Update: Tim Taylor provided a Hillholder newsletter report. He asked if anyone was having any problem getting their newsletter. Tim's bi-monthly routine is to use the email addresses from the latest version of our club chapter Membership Roster, and then send the Hillholder approximately two weeks prior to the forthcoming meeting.

Old Business: There was some further discussion by Bill on ways to support Studebaker "legacy."

New Business:

• The club currently has adopted a car in the Studebaker National Museum, and we might possibly want to adopt another.

- Bill Startt reported that there is an Avanti on display at the Miles through Time Museum in Clarksville. [See photos on page 5 of this Hillholder.]
- Bill suggested that we consider something like a legacy fund. He suggested that as a chapter or on an individual basis, we could donate to a charity for scholarships such as RPM Foundation for young adults interested in auto restoration and vintage car repair, or possibly the Bob Palma Internship.
- Hemmings Magazine also has a foundation towards similar pursuits. As described in that magazine, the internship affords experience in transportation museum studies and research, preservation and conservation, collections management, and exhibit research and development. SDC has just approved an internship at the National Museum in honor of Bob Palma. The Board of Directors has approved funding for two years. Bob was an active contributor and author to Turning Wheels and Hemmings Classic Car magazines.
- Alan Z. inquired as to how much money would the chapter be interested in donating. Bill suggested
 that possibly a committee could be formed by the chapter to think about that or possibly on an
 individual basis. Meeting attendees gave this idea good vocal support. Terry Z. suggested any other
 ideas could be submitted to the Hillholder.
- Bill S. reported that the South Georgia chapter takes money from the club treasury (from their dues) to give to charity on a regular basis. Our dues would need to increase if the club were to pursue that sort of action on a regular basis.
- Bill asked if the club was content with meeting at restaurants or if members would be interested in having meetings at a member's home. Something to think about. Next meeting will be August 6th in Morrow, GA. Details will be in the Hillholder and the NGSDC Facebook page.

Adjournment:

After completing our agenda and all related discussions, Bill adjourned the meeting at approximately 3:10 PM.





Date: Sunday, August 6


Time: 2:00 PM.
